

ARIS LIEM shooting in Beijing, China Winter at the Great Wall, with so many people wearing red coats, its like red dragon lying down on the snow.




**REQUEL LEGASPINO** shooting in Iligan City, Philippines

This young man jumped from a tree branch on a cliff with a height of more or less than 60 feet from sea. He had no gadgets for his safety, and his only weapon is no fear.


